IPP:

PPP:

ADA:

1. When the patient was entered in to the database is no longer considered when querying for ADA education.
2. In the ADA report, the number of Black patients was inaccurate. This has been fixed.

IPP:

1. Non-smokers tobacco intervention in the IPP was showing up as "unknown". The word "unknown" has been removed for non-smokers.

Print IPPs for Last Modified Date:

Modified Today option under Reports >> IPP has been replaced with Last Modified Date. This allows the user to select the last modified date instead of allowing to print only the IPPs modified today.

Problem 1:

The IPP errors out if there are more than 2 records of tobacco intervention with Insulin Counseling.

Solution:

Corrected the typo in the temporary table so that the records can be inserted correctly.

Problem 2:

When deleting a tobacco record from the history form, an error message pops up saying that another user is attempting to modify the record even though the record gets deleted successfully.

Solution:

Commented out the delete code in the form. Since the form is already bound, the delete code is unnecessary.

Add a box for selecting one or more of these tobacco intervention options, if the intervention is marked as Yes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Counseling- Cessation Group- Quit Line- Rx/NRT- Other <p>B. Add the tobacco intervention criteria to the PPP criteria form, history form, and the PPP report. (Liz and Todd will send the criteria.) Do not add this to the IPP report or the QS report.</p> <p>C. 6.	<p>Population Practice Profile (v1.5 & v1.6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. On the selection criteria form, change each date option to say “from xx/xx/xx to xx/xx/xx” in place of “since xx/xx/xx. Set the default for the dates to a 1-year period. B. On the selection criteria form, program the Office Visit date selection on the demographic selection criteria form to automatically change the above dates if the user changes the office visit date. 8.	<p>Demographic Data Entry (v1.5 & v1.6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Change the city into a drop down box, functioning just like the physicians drop down box.
9.	<p>Medication (v1.5 & v1.6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Add Incretin as a permanent med in the list. B. Add Incretin to the IPP (in the Diabetes Medication section), history form, and Advanced Search criteria.
10.	<p>Education (v1.5 & v1.6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Add Insulin Counseling under the Education list.
11.	<p>ADA Education Data Entry (v1.6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Create a separate menu item for all ADA data entry and reports. B. For ADA data entry form: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Change the education types from “Follow up” to “Post Prog Inst” and from “Comprehensive” to “Comp/Initial Recvd.” - Move the completed data entry from the daily entry area to a checkbox at the bottom of the form. 12.	<p>ADA Education Recognition Report (v1.6)</p> <p>A. Change the ADA Recognition Report as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - First line should read: “Total number of patients who received any ADA education during specified time frame.” The total number of patients for this line will only be patients who received ADA education and will not be related to the total patients in DQCMS at all. - Second line should read: “Total number of patients classified as having comprehensive/initial DSME during specified time frame. - Third line should read: “Total number of patients classified as having Post Program Instruction DSME during specified time frame.” - The label for the second group should change from “Average per Person” to “Average Hours.” Eliminate the total column for “Average of Total Population.” - In the fourth group box, “Age of patients receiving any education during specified time frame,” the line for “Total number of patients” will calculate the same total number of patients as in the very first line. Thus the percentage column may not add up to 100, as we may not have an age on every patient in the database that received any education. - Change the line item for “American Indian (AI/AN)” to read “American Indian/Alaskan Native.”
